ARGOS is an animal protection association that helps in the reception, protection and maintenance of abandoned domestic animals.



Lost

- If you lose your pet, you can contact to ARGOS and they try to find it.
- They share its image on the web and social networks to make it more visible and easier to find.



Ethical colony management

- Feeding a colony of cats is not enough to ensure their survival; Cat population needs to be controlled, that is why feed them is largely avoided with an ethical control of the colony using C.E.R. application.
- They are captured with a cage with food covering it quickly to avoid stress. Then they are transferred to a veterinary clinic to be sterilized. Then they return to their original colony so that they can continue with their life.

Ethical colony management

- They are marked on the right ear for the females and the left for the males so that they are not captured again.
- In this association they usually feed the animals with dry food because that is the best for their nutrition and for the rest of citizens.



Adoption

- ARGOS rarely has Dogs, the few ones they have are for people to adopt them as a pet and never to be dedicated as a farm guard or similar, same thing is applied to their cats destinated to be a pet too.
- Dogs are adopted externally and internally dewormed with a microchip and rabies vaccine if they are older than three months or puppy vaccine that is key for the younger ones.

Adoption

- The cats are also dewormed and tested for feline trivalent vaccine.
- As a general rule, animals older than six or seven months are already sterilized.




Shelter houses
